Rattles were one of the first music instruments and are unearthed by archeologists around the world. Handcrafted from inventive materials by resourceful peoples, the artifacts are testament to the innovation and resilience of humankind, as well as to the human spirit.

innerSpirit Rattles' tiny balls tucked inside the pillow of clay make a soft soothing sound when picked up from its nestling spot on a desk or vanity and are a subtle reminder of humanity's musical connection and of our resiliency throughout time.

Native Americans used rattles to bestow blessings upon their crops. Use your rattle to help rattle some rain into your life, some rain out of your life, to rattle your worries away, or just to keep your papers from blowing astray.
